IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT to Construct a Bridge Between Lubec and Campobello Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Highway bridge between Lubec and Campobello Island. The State Highway Commission is authorized to construct, in conjunction with the Government of Canada or the Province of New Brunswick, or both, an international, free highway bridge across the waters between the Town of Lubec in Washington County and Campobello Island in the Province of New Brunswick, Canada, and approaches to said bridge. Such bridge shall not be constructed until the Government of Canada or the Province of New Brunswick, or both, shall provide a sum of money adequate to pay its or their share of the cost.

The expenditure of any state or federal funds available for such bridge and approaches thereto, and the location, planning and construction of the bridge as far as the State of Maine is concerned shall be under the direction and supervision of the State Highway Commission.

The State Highway Commission is authorized and empowered to accept for the State any federal funds available for the purposes of this act.

The sum of \$300,000 is hereby allocated from the income to the General Highway Fund from July 1, 1959 to June 30, 1960 to carry out the purposes of this act.
