#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Issuance of Hunting Licenses by Any Town Clerk.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 73, sub-§ III, amended. The 2nd paragraph of subsection III of section 73 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'The license may be issued to a resident by the clerk or agent in the any town in which the applicant resides or if domiciled in an unorganized territory then by the clerk or agent in the nearest town, upon payment of a fee of \$2.75, of which 25c shall be retained by the town clerk or agent. The commissioner may appoint agents in unorganized towns for the purpose of issuing resident hunting licenses to the residents domiciled in that unorganized town.
