STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Residence of Trustees of Monmouth Academy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Act of Incorporation of Trustees of a Free Grammar School in the Town of Monmouth and County of Kennebec, (Monmouth Academy) Section 5th, amended. Section 5th of the Act of Incorporation of the Trustees of Monmouth Academy, enacted by the General Court of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts on the 22nd day of February, 1803, said Act being amended by the said General Court on June 19, 1809, is further amended to read as follows:

'Section 5th. Be it further enacted, that the number of said trustees shall not at any one time be more than 11, or less than 7; 5 of whom shall constitute a quorum to do business and that a majority of said Trustees shall consist of men who are not inhabitants of said Monmouth.
