STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Pilots for the Port of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1917, c. 192, § 10, amended. The last paragraph of section 10 of chapter 192 of the private and special laws of 1917, as repealed and replaced by chapter 24 of the private and special laws of 1927, is amended to read as follows:

‘Said branch may be revoked at any time by said board, for negligence, incapacity, or for any other reason that said board may deem sufficient. The branch, so granted, shall be recorded by the **secretary or** clerk of said board in a book kept for that purpose, entitled “Pilots for the Port of Portland”; and the ~~clerk board~~ shall receive from the applicant, for making such record, the sum of ~~five dollars~~ \$25.’
