STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Source of Supply of Bangor Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1957, c. 39, § 2, amended. The 1st sentence of section 2 of chapter 39 of the private and special laws of 1957 is amended to read as follows:

'The said district, for the purposes of its incorporation, is hereby authorized and empowered to purchase, take, hold, divert, use and distribute water from Floods Pond, Burnt Pond and Little Burnt Pond, Spectacle pond, Beech Hill pond, Snowshoe pond, and Fitts pond in the Counties of Penobscot and Hancock, as the case may be, or any of them.'
