RESOLVE, To Purchase One Hundred Copies of "History of Otisfield."

Copies of "History of Otisfield;" purchased.

RESOLVED: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,250 for the State to purchase 100 copies of the book entitled "History of Otisfield," written by William S. Spurr, at \$12.50 per copy, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is an historical account of the Town of Otisfield. It has been the practice of previous Legislatures to encourage such literary work and thus help to preserve the history of the State and its municipalities, and to enlighten the people of Maine as to the importance of such history.
