STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Free Fishing Licenses for Certain Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 37, § 39, sub-§ IX-A, additional. Section 39 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new subsection IX-A, as follows:
 - 'IX-A. The Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game shall issue without any charge or fee a fishing license to any veteran within the meaning of chapter 26, section 10, subsection IV, who has visual acuity of 5/200 or less after correction, providing the veteran presents a certificate from the Veterans Administration stating that the person described is such a disabled veteran.'
