STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Regulating Black Bass Fishing in Belgrade Lakes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 37, § 44, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 44 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:
 - 'II. There shall be an open season for black bass in lakes and ponds from June 21st to September 30th, except that there shall be an open season for black bass in Belgrade Lakes from May 1st to September 30th; in rivers above tidewater from June 21st to September 15th; in brooks and streams from June 21st to August 15th. Three black bass per day on single-pointed hooked artificial lures only may be taken from June 1st to June 20th and no person shall have in his possession at any one time more than 3 black bass during this period.'
