STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Return of Writs in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 106, § 10, amended. Section 10 of chapter 106 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 10. Writs when returnable. All writs of the Superior Court returnable at a regular term of court in the County of Cumberland shall be made returnable at one of the next 3 terms to be begun and held after the issuing thereof and in the Counties of Androscoggin, Kennebec and; Penobscot and York a one of the next 2 terms to be so begun and held. In all other counties such writ shall be made returnable at the first term of court to be held more than 14 day after issuing thereof.'
