IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Qualifications for Appointment to Auburn Police and Fire Departments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1917, c. 201, Art. VI, § 3, sub-§ (5), amended. Subsection (5) of section 3 of Article VI of chapter 201 of the private and special laws of 1917, as repealed and replaced by section 10 of chapter 47 of the private and special laws of 1943, is amended to read as follows:

‘(5) Applicants for appointment to the fire department shall be not less than 5 feet ~~5~~ 8 inches in height and weigh not less than ~~130~~ 140 pounds and shall be not less than 21 years of age or not over 34 years of age. Applicants for appointment to the call force shall be not less than 21 years of age and not more than 40 years of age.

Applicants for appointment in the fire department who have been serving as call men for not less than 2 years prior to their application may be appointed to the permanent force of the fire department if not over 36 years of age.

Applicants for appointment to the police department shall be not less than 5 feet 8 inches in height and weigh not less than 140 pounds and shall be not less than 21 years of age and not over ~~30~~ 34 years of age.’
