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**AN ACT Changing Name of the Young Men's Christian Association of  
Auburn to The Young Men's Christian Association of Auburn-Lewiston.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1868, c. 519, § 1, amended.** Section 1 of chapter 519 of the private and special laws of 1868 is amended to read as follows:

'**Sec. 1. Corporators; name and purpose; capital and powers.** R. W. Hanscom, Frank L. Dingley, John F. Cobb and Thomas A. D. Fessenden, their associates and successors, are hereby created a body politic and corporate, by the name of ~~the~~ **The Young Men's Christian Association of Auburn-Lewiston**, with power to take and hold, for religious, educational and charitable purposes, property, real and personal, to the amount of \$50,000, and may sell and convey the same; and said corporation shall have all the powers and privileges, and be subject to all the duties and liabilities, of similar corporations in this State.'
