RESOLVE, Amending the Resolve Authorizing the Commissioner of Finance and Administration to Convey Certain Land of the State in York County.

Resolves, 1957, c. 89, amended. Resolved: That the first paragraph of chapter 89 of the Resolves of 1957 be, and is, repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'That the Commissioner of Finance and Administration be, and is, authorized to convey to the Town of Wells, to be used for a town library, which would revert to the State when and if such use was discontinued, for a token sum of \$2,500, the interest of the State in the following described land:'

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The land involved in this resolve was used by the Maine State Police in Wells as barracks. This land is no longer used for this purpose and the plan is to utilize it for a town library.
