**RESOLVE, to Complete the Classroom and Library Building at
Gorham State Teachers' College.**

Gorham State Teachers' College; completion of classroom and library building. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,105,700 in favor of Gorham State Teachers' College for the completion of the classroom and library building at Gorham State Teachers' College; and be it further

Resolved: That this appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENTS OF FACTS

Gorham State Teachers' College is extremely overcrowded, and the completion of the classroom and library building will provide for present enrollment and future expansion, directly resulting in providing more teachers for the State of Maine.
