STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Setting Lobster Traps Near Weirs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 121, amended. Section 121 of chapter 38 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 121. Traps not to be set near fish weir. No person shall set any lobster trap within 300 feet of from the mouth of any fish weir or within 100 feet from any part of the leaders of any fish weir and no person shall set any lobster trap between the leaders of any fish weir under a penalty of \$10 for each offense.'
