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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Lawrence Babb of Augusta.**

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**Lawrence Babb; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and is, appropriated from the General Highway Fund of the State the sum of \$1,550 to be paid to Lawrence Babb of Augusta, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage to his well caused by blasting.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The damage to Mr. Babb's well occurred the latter part of June, 1958 after excessive blasting while constructing a new road and during the continuation of the turnpike crossing Winthrop road and running parallel with the Leighton road. Before the blasting, Mr. Babb's well was producing  $4\frac{1}{2}$  gallons of water per minute and it was estimated by the State Engineering Department that after the blasting the well was producing only  $\frac{1}{2}$  gallon per minute.
