HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 58, L. D. 91, Bill, "An Act Concerning
Liability of Parents for Damage by Children."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated
"Sec. 22-A." and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 22-A. Liability of parents for damage by children. The
parent or parents of any minor who is between 7 and 17 years of age
and is living with said parent or parents, which minor or minors
willfully or maliciously cause damage to any property or injury to
any person, shall be jointly and severally liable with such minor
or minors for such damage or injury to an amount not exceeding \$250,
if such minor or minors would have been liable for such damage or
injury if they had been adults. Nothing in this section shall be
construed to relieve such minor or minors from personal liability
for such damage or injury."
