STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Revising the Laws Relating to the Bureau of Public Improvements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 15-A, § 25, sub-§ III, repealed and replaced. Subsection III of section 25 of chapter 15-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 340 of the public laws of 1957, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'III. Upon request, provide programming and financial advice to all state departments and agencies in connection with all engineering and architectural questions and matters pertaining to any and all public improvements;'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 15-A, § 25, sub-§ VI, repealed and replaced. Subsection VI of section 25 of chapter 15-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 340 of the public laws of 1957, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'VI. To approve the selection of qualified practicing Maine registered architects and engineers in the planning and supervision of construction and public improvements;'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 15-A, § 25, sub-§§ VII, IX, repealed. Subsections VII and IX of section 25 of chapter 15-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 340 of the public laws of 1957, are repealed.

Sec. 4. R. S., c. 15-A, § 25, sub-§ XV, amended. Subsection XV of section 25 of chapter 15-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 340 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'XV. To have general supervision of the State House and the public grounds, buildings and property connected with the State House, and make or supervise the making of all construction, repairs, alterations and improvements in and about such grounds and buildings;'
