IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Salary of the Judge of Waldo County Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1941, c. 12, § 2, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 2 of chapter 12 of the private and special laws of 1941, as amended by chapter 150 of the private and special laws of 1953 and by chapter 183 of the private and special laws of 1955, is further amended to read as follows:

'Said judge shall receive a salary of ~~\$2,250~~ \$3,600 per year and said recorder shall receive a salary of \$1,000 per year for all services in criminal and civil cases, to be paid from the treasury of the County of Waldo in monthly payments on the last day of each month.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1959.
