AN ACT Increasing Salary of Judge of the Lincoln Municipal Court, Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1913, c. 239, § 19, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 19 of chapter 239 of the private and special laws of 1913, as last amended by section 33 of chapter 160 of the private and special laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

‘The judge of said court shall receive the salary of ~~\$2,500~~ \$2,800 per year, to be paid him in equal quarterly payments from the county treasury of Lincoln County, which shall be in full for his services as such judge, except as hereinbefore provided.’

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1959.
