AN ACT Increasing Clerk Hire and Salaries of Certain Lincoln County Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 98, amended. That part of section 98 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes which relates to the salary of the clerk of courts of Lincoln County, as last amended by section 42 of chapter 416 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln, ~~\$3,400~~ \$3,500.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 153, § 3, amended. That part of section 3 of chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes which relates to the salary of judge of probate of Lincoln County, as last amended by section 46 of chapter 416 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln, ~~\$2,700~~ \$2,800.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 153, § 22, amended. That part of section 22 of chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes which relates to the salary of the register of probate of Lincoln County, as last amended by section 47 of chapter 416 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln, ~~\$2,500~~ \$2,600.'

Sec. 4. Effective date. This act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1959.
