RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Grace Pond, Somerset County.

Grace Pond; regulating fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Grace Pond in Upper Enchanted Township, Somerset County, to fishing under the general law. The use of live bait is prohibited.
