IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Permitting Ice Fishing in Certain Ponds in Androscoggin and Kennebec Counties.

Certain ponds in Androscoggin and Kennebec Counties; opened to ice fishing.

Resolve: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening the following ponds to ice fishing for all fish:

Rack Pond, Androscoggin County,

Round Pond, Androscoggin County,

Turner Pond, Androscoggin County,

Burgess Pond, Kennebec County,

Mud Pond, Kennebec County,

School House Pond, Androscoggin and Kennebec Counties.
