AN ACT Relating to Quinellas at Harness Race Meets.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 86, § 11, amended. The last sentence of section 11 of chapter 86 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 382 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'Quinellas or any similar types of designations shall be permitted at any harness race or race meet each day ~~for the last heat only of the race conducted on any particular day~~ at the discretion of the commission.'
