**AN ACT Relating to Chairman of Superintending School Committee of
City of Portland.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1923, c. 109, Art. IV, § 2, Repealed and replaced. Section 2 of Article IV of chapter 109 of the private and special laws of 1923 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 2. Chairman; election, term. At the first meeting, or as soon thereafter as possible, the superintending school committee shall elect one of its members as chairman for the ensuing year and until his successor is elected and qualified, and may fill for the unexpired term any vacancy as chairman that may occur. The city council shall designate one of its members to serve with the superintending school committee, but he shall have no vote and shall serve without compensation.'
