Bill, "An Act Changing the Date of Labor Day to the Second
Monday in September."

Amend said Amendment by adding at the end, before the period,
the following:

'and provided further that on or before January 1, 1961 the Governor,
after determining that a majority of the above-named states has
provided for the observance of Labor Day on the same day as pro-
vided in this act, shall by proclamation proclaim that this act
is effective'
