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**RESOLVE, Establishing Control Program for Abatement of  
Mosquitoes in Cranberry Isles.**

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**Cranberry Isles; establishing control program for abatement of mosquitoes.**  
**Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$5,000 to be expended by the Town of Cranberry Isles in carrying out such lawful programs as it may deem necessary for the abatement of mosquito nuisances and the eradication of the same in said town; and be it further

**Resolved:** That such appropriation shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purpose of this resolve has been accomplished.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

The Town of Cranberry Isles is financially incapable of appropriating such sums as are needed to offset the costs of necessary measures desperately needed to control mosquito breeding places in said town, and abate thereby, the prevalence of mosquitoes which constitutes a serious menace to the health and well-being of its inhabitants.
