**RESOLVE, to Provide Funds for Matching Federal Funds for
Training in Fisheries Trades.**

Matching Funds; appropriated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to the State Department of Education from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the State the sum of \$15,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960 and \$15,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961 for additional class at Maine Vocational Technical Institute in South Portland to match federal funds allocated to Maine under P. L. 1027, 84th Congress to establish vocational education training in the fisheries trades.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Federal funds are available to establish vocational education training in the fisheries trades. This resolve is for the purpose of matching these federal funds. Operating facilities are now available for such a course at Maine Vocational Technical Institute in South Portland.
