IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Permits for Outdoor Advertising.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 147, amended. Section 147 of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 279 of the public laws of 1955, is further amended by inserting after the first sentence the following sentences:

'The application for a permit under section 138, when such outdoor advertising is to be located outside the compact or built-up section of any municipality, shall contain a certificate stating that the proposed structure, device or display is in conformity with existing municipal ordinances. Such certificate shall be executed by the municipal officers or their duly appointed agent.'
