#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Temporary Fish and Game Wardens and Warden Commissions to Permenent Employees of Fish and Game Department.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 37, § 29, sub-§§ V and VI, additional. Section 29 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding 2 new subsections to be numbered V and VI, to read as follows:
  - 'V. The commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game may employ persons as wardens on a temporary basis without the examination required by this section.
  - VI. The Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game may commission any permanent employee of the department as a warden without the examination required by this section.'
