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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Millionth Visitor, Inc.**

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**Millionth Visitor, Inc.; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960 and \$1,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961 in favor of the Millionth Visitor, Inc. of Portland for the purpose of promoting the Millionth Visitor celebration on a state-wide basis.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

The Millionth Visitor, Inc. is a charitable non-profit civic corporation duly organized and licensed under the laws of the State of Maine and having a place of business in Portland. Its purpose is to promote the Millionth Visitor celebration on a state-wide basis and to enhance and promote Maine as a vacation land and an industrial area of unparalleled excellence.

For this purpose the Millionth Visitor celebration has an annual budget of approximately \$7,000 and makes a request for a grant of an additional \$1,500 each year for the purpose of promoting the celebration on a state-wide basis.
