HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to S. P. 82, L. D. 154, Bill, "An Act Relating to Minimum Wages."

Amend said Bill by adding after paragraph G of subsection III of section 132-B the following underlined paragraph:

'H. Any individual who is regularly enrolled in an educational institution, or on vacation therefrom, and those individuals such as waiters, waitresses and the like who customarily receive gratuities in the form of tips as part of their remuneration.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined sentence of subsection V of section 132-B.
