SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 85, L. D. 157, Resolve, Proposing an
Amendment to the Constitution for Appointment of Attorney
General by the Governor with Consent of the Senate.

Amend said Resolve, in the Title, by striking out the word
"Senate" and inserting in place thereof the word 'Council'

Further amend said Resolve in the 3rd line of that part designated
"Section 11" by striking out the underlined word "Senate" and insert-
ing in place thereof the underlined word 'Council'

Further amend said Resolve, in the last line of the 3rd paragraph
from the end, by striking out the word "Senate" and inserting in place
thereof the word 'Council'
