STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Aid Settlement of Refugees in Maine.

Appropriation; aid to refugees. Resolved: That there be, and is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$5,000 for secretarial and other administrative expenses of the Governor in aiding the settlement of refugees in the State of Maine; and be it further

Resolved: That the Governor is authorized to consult with a committee, to be composed of such interested citizens of Maine as the Governor may choose, to coordinate the efforts of groups which are active in aiding the settlement of such refugees in the State of Maine; and be it further

Resolved: That any unexpended balances of the money appropriated by this resolve shall lapse on June 30, 1961.
