RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Howland.

Town of Howland; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,523.94 to be paid to the Town of Howland to reimburse said town for aid extended to Priscilla Leeman.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Town of Howland requests reimbursement for the amount of \$1,523.94 for aid extended to Priscilla Leeman and children during the years 1950 to 1958. The town paid the State the above sum on the assumption that the Town of Howland was Mrs. Leeman's place of settlement. The place of settlement has since been found to be Edinburg.
