HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 109, L. D. 164, Bill, "An Act Regulating Live Bait for Fishing."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by inserting after the word "Live" the punctuation and words ', Dormant or Dead'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the first underlined paragraph, including the headnote, and inserting in place thereof the following underlined headnote and paragraph:

'Sec. 63. Live, dormant or dead bait; dealers licensed. It shall be unlawful to sell, use or have in possession fish bait, live, dormant or dead, or any pickerel, goldfish, yellow perch, white perch, bass, sunfish, bluegills, crappie, hornpout, carp or any spiny-finned fish for use as bait for fishing in the inland waters of this State. This section shall not apply to bait in a preserve container which has a preservative chemical strong enough to kill all parasites or parasite egg cells. This paragraph shall apply only to the importation of bait into this State.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined paragraph.
