RESOLVE Providing for a State Pension for Jeanne L. Lebrun of Lewiston.

Jeanne L. Lebrun, state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Jeanne L. Lebrun, of Lewiston, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1959 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Lebrun is 50 years old and has never been able to earn her own living because of poor health. After the death of her parents she was cared for by a sister, who is now financially unable to help further, as are other members of her family. She is under constant doctor's care and has been hospitalized several times.
