RESOLVE, Appropriation for the Purchase of Informational Materials for Use in the Education of Retarded Children.

Purchase of informational materials; appropriation. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to the Department of Education from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$600 for the purchase of informational materials for use in the education of retarded children.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The appropriation asked for is to aid in the education of retarded children by the purchase of materials to be used by interested groups such as schools, farm groups, etc.
