STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Average Daily Membership Required for School Administrative Districts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § III-E, amended. The first paragraph of section III-E of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section I-B of chapter 364 and as repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 443, both of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'The School District Commission may approve the formation of School Administrative Districts which had at least 300 200 resident secondary pupils educated at public expense in grades 9 through 12 as indicated in the last returns made to the Commissioner of Education under section 71.'
