SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 145, L. D. 201, Bill, "An Act to
Authorize the Construction of a Causeway Connecting Cousins
Island with Littlejohns Island, and a Bridge and Causeway
Connecting Littlejohns with Chebeague Island."

Amend said Bill, in Section 2, by striking out the last 3 words
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'and retirement of bonds issued, except that such tolls shall not be
reduced until the income from tolls for any one year shall exceed
the amount necessary to meet the charges enumerated herein.'

Further amend said Bill, in section 3, by inserting after the
word "act" in the last line thereof the following:

', provided that said bonds shall be sold on the express condition
that toll charges, once established, shall not be reduced until the
income from such tolls shall exceed in any one year, the amount
necessary to cover the cost of upkeep, maintenance, repairs and
operation, and interest on and retirement of bonds issued'
