RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Cupsuptic River, Franklin County.

Fishing in Cupsuptic River; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Cupsuptic River, in Adamstown, Franklin County to fishing from September 15th to October 1st with a daily bag limit of one fish per person.
