RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Bemis Stream, Franklin County.

Fishing in Bemis Stream; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Bemis Stream, Rangeley Plantation, Franklin County to fishing from September 14th to October 1st with a daily bag limit of one fish per person.
