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**AN ACT Relating to Color of Private School Buses.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 48, amended.** The last paragraph of section 48 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'School buses with a carrying capacity of over 20 passengers must comply with the Uniform School Bus Standards, **except that no private school now owning or operating a school bus or buses for the transportation of children to or from school, which comply in all other respects to the Uniform School Bus Standards except color, shall be required to repaint said bus or buses in order to comply therewith.**'
