RESOLVE, in Favor of Robert H. Anderson of Falls Church, Virginia.

Robert H. Anderson; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and is, appropriated from the funds of the State Liquor Commission the sum of \$110 to be paid to Robert H. Anderson of Falls Church, Virginia, to reimburse him for a retail malt liquor license issued for the year 1958, and which he was unable to use because the property was destroyed by fire 6 weeks later.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

For a period of 5 years up to February 15, 1958, Mr. Anderson operated a store at 162 New County Road, Rockland, under the name of Anderson's Market. On February 15, 1958 his business and home were completely destroyed by fire.

Inasmuch as Mr. Anderson had renewed his beer license for the year 1958 and since this license was used only 6 weeks because of the fire, Mr. Anderson now requests a refund of the unused amount or the total of \$110.
