### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of Town of Bethel for Aid to Charles F. Cone.

Town of Bethel; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the State the sum of \$31 to be paid to the Town of Bethel, to reimburse it for aid to Charles F. Cone.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The file on this case shows that a letter was received from the Division of General Relief under date of January 14, 1949 stating that Charles F. Cone was accepted as a non-settled case in March 1936 and that reimbursement would be made by this Division for any necessary assistance.

Public Assistance records show that he was granted Old Age Assistance in 1951, thereby freezing his settlement as a non-settled case.

Supplemental assistance was furnished Mr. Cone in 1956 to the amount of \$31. Claims were never filed with the Division of General Relief for reimbursement.
