RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Peep Lake, Washington County.

Fishing in Peep Lake, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of 5 trout, prohibiting ice fishing for trout and prohibiting the use or possession of live fish as bait on Peep Lake, T. 30, M.D., Washington County.
