RESOLVE Opening Big Pleasant Lake and Spider Lake in Piscataquis County
to Ice Fishing.

Fishing in Big Pleasant Lake and Spider Lake, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized to issue a rule and regulation opening Big Pleasant Lake, T9, R11 and T10, R11 and Spider Lake, T9, R11 and T9, R12, both in Piscataquis County, to ice fishing during February and March under the general laws.
