AN ACT Relating to Fluoridation of Public Water Supplies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 145, amended. Section 145 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 303 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended by inserting after the 8th sentence a new sentence, to read as follows:

'Whenever a municipality shall have voted against fluoridation in its water supply, fluoridation shall not again be voted upon by said town for a minimum period of 2 years from date of such adverse vote.'
