RESOLVE, Providing State Pension for Lorraine White of Patten.

Lorraine White; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and is, granted to Lorraine White, of Patten, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1959 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Lorraine White has no other source of income. Lorraine does not qualify for the Disabled Act as she is not disabled and her mental capacity is beyond that of an 8 year old child.
