"The Story of Houlton"; purchase of. Resolved: That the State purchase 100 copies of "The Story of Houlton," compiled by Cora M. Putnam, at a price not exceeding \$10 per copy, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian; and be it further

Resolved: That there be, and is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000 for this purpose.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This book is a history of the Town of Houlton, Aroostook County. It should be purchased by the State and distributed to various sources as an historical reference.
