STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Conferring Degrees by Thomas Junior College.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Degrees. In addition to the rights, privileges and powers granted to Thomas Junior College, by Chapter 54 of the Revised Statutes of Maine, 1954, as amended, said Thomas Junior College, by appropriate action of its trustees, may confer upon all who shall satisfactorily complete such courses of study as said trustees may prescribe, within the scope customarily established by junior colleges offering a 2-year curriculum, the degrees of Associate in Arts and Associate in Secretarial Science.
